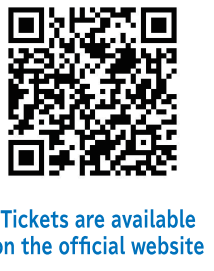

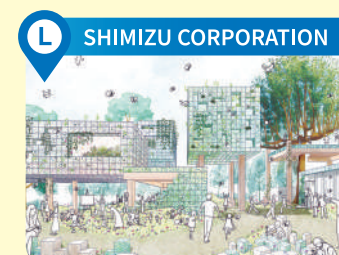
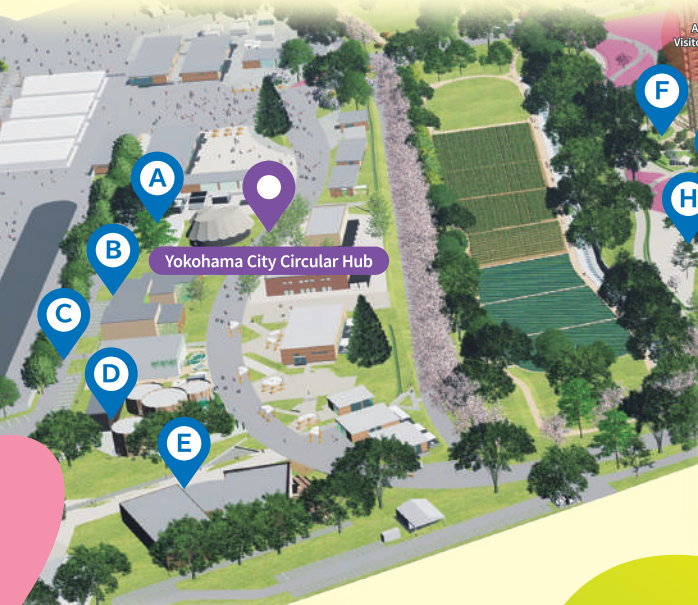

# Blossom Together with the Earth.

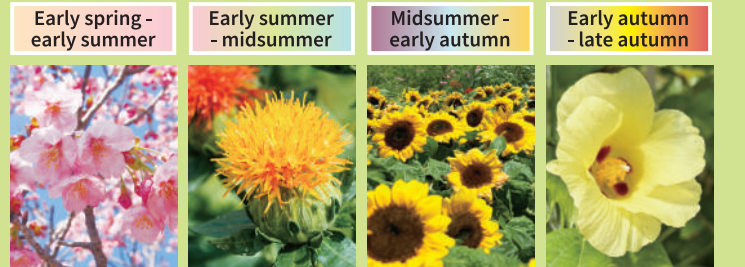
Welcome to a vibrant journey around the world, brought to life by 10 million plants and flowers.

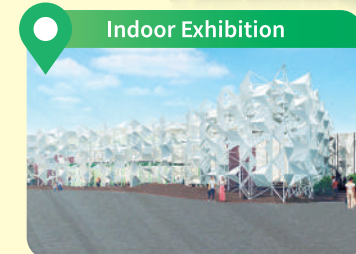
### The different flowers that will bloom during the 6-month duration of the expo
