## **1. INTRODUCTION**

### **1-1. PURPOSE**

The purpose of ensure safety and maintain order at the EXPO Site , stipulate prohibited items and prohibited acts within the venue in accordance with Special Regulation No. 13.

### **1-2. SCOPE**

These Rules and Regulations apply to all general visitors to the Expo Site, excluding the Organiser, Official Participants, and related persons.

### **1-3. LEGAL COMPLIANCE, ETC.**

When entering the Expo Site , the relevant Japanese laws and ordinances of Kanagawa Prefecture and Yokohama City must be observed. In addition, if other guidelines, materials or other relevant standards are presented by the Organiser in addition to these Rules and Regulations, they must also be observed.

## **2. SECURITY INSPECTION AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION**

At the entrance gate, visitors and their belongings are inspected by X ray inspection equipment, and some belongings are opened for direct inspection.

## **3. PROHIBITED ITEMS**

The following items shall be prohibited from being brought into the Expo Site without the Organiser's permission.

### **3-1. Prohibited Items (Dangerous Items, ETC.)**

- Explosives, Dangerous items, and Toxic, Hazardous substances.
- Items with the risk of explosion, ignition, generation of toxic gas, etc.
- Weapons and deadly weapons, cutting instruments (Guns, swords, cutting instruments such as knives and scissors, rifles, handcuffs, water guns, sprayers, etc.)

\*This includes manufactured items, imitations, toys, and handmade items.

- Pepper spray, which can cause bodily harm or cause discomfort to others.
- Combustible items such as fireworks, gas cylinders, large quantities of lighters and matches.
- Items that could be potentially used as lethal weapons such as golf clubs, bats and rackets.
- Insect nets, etc. a long, rod-shaped object.
- Other items whose possession is prohibited by laws and regulations.

### **3-2. Prohibited Items (Other)**

- All alcoholic beverages (regardless of container or whether open or unopened)
- Beverages in bottles and cans (except in cases where dietary restrictions apply, such as food allergies)

\*Bringing in your own personal bottles and water bottles is recommended. Plastic bottles are also acceptable.

- Plants and Animals, excluding Assistance dogs (Guide dogs for the blind, Service dogs, and Hearing dogs)
- Radio communication equipment such as amateur radio equipment, specified low-power radio equipment, walkie-talkies, etc. (excludes mobile phones, radios [those that are not used for communication], personal computers and tablets), small unmanned aircraft (drones, etc.), radio-controlled toys.
- Banners, horizontal banners, and other similar items.
- Loudspeakers, megaphones, and other items that may make noise.

- Roller skates, skateboards, kickboards, bicycles, and other items that may interfere with the passage of others (excluding mobility aids)
- Hard cases and suitcases, carts such as those that carry goods, carry cases, etc.
- Camera monopods or tripods, selfie sticks (except hand-sized ones that fit in the palm of your hand), and other items that could be potentially used as weapons.
- Other items deemed inappropriate in terms of order and safety measures at the Expo Site.
- Other items prohibited from being possessed by laws and regulations.
- Baggage that exceeds the size limits for X-ray screening (excluding walking aids, wheelchairs, and strollers used by the elderly, people with disabilities, etc.)

#### **4. PROHIBITED ACTS**

The following acts are prohibited in the exhibition grounds without The Organiser's permission.

##### **4-1. Prohibited Acts (Dangerous acts, etc.)**

- Obstructing the passage of people, vehicles, mobility, etc. or acting in a manner that obstructs or endangers the passage of people, vehicles or mobility.
- Carrying items that may harm a person's body or property, or engaging in acts that may cause harm
- Spraying substances (gases, liquids, powders, or other) , or leaving them unattended.
- Entering restricted areas.
- Doing any gliding by using roller skates, roller shoes, skateboards, kickboards, bicycles, etc.

(Excludes personal mobility lent by the Japan Association for the 2027 Horticultural Exposition. When entering the Expo Site while wearing roller shoes, the roller part(s) must be removed or retracted.)

- Swimming and fishing are prohibited within the Expo Site.

##### **4-2. Prohibited Acts (Acts of vandalism, etc.)**

- Damaging or defacing exhibits, facilities, equipment, or other items used for the Expo.
- Collecting or damaging plants, insects, etc. (except for activities associated with experiences offered within the venue)
- Feeding, capturing, or killing birds, animals, fish, or shellfish.

#### **4-3. Prohibited acts (Prohibited use, Distribution, etc.)**

- Use of loudspeakers, megaphones, speakers, or any other devices that may generate excessive noise.
- Displaying or carrying large placards, banner flag, or similar items.  
(Tour guides and others are permitted to use hand flags (approximately 45 cm × 45 cm), but care must be taken not to disturb other visitors.)
- Displaying or distributing posters, leaflets, flyers, etc.
- Use of amateur radio equipment and specified low-power radio equipment (excluding mobile phones, radios, computers, and tablets), small unmanned aircraft (drones, etc.), and radio-controlled toys
- Using camera monopods or tripods, selfie sticks (excluding hand-sized ones that fit in the palm of the hand)

#### **4-4. Prohibited Acts (Other Prohibited Acts)**

- Drinking alcohol outside the area where it is sold or served.
- Discarding paper scraps, containers, other waste, or litter in areas other than those designated
- Bringing garbage from outside the Expo Site, such as household garbage, into the Expo Site and disposing of it.
- Business activities, display of goods, etc. (including distribution of souvenirs, etc.), and photographing and recording for commercial purposes.
- Smoking in areas other than designated smoking areas is dangerous from a fire prevention perspective.
- Solicitation of donations, petition activities, other solicitations, or conducting surveys (sampling, questionnaires, etc.) and requests for answers to such surveys.
- Mass demonstrations, rallies, and speeches
- Acts involving political, ideological, or religious beliefs or views.

- Acts contrary to public order and morality.
- Planting plants or sowing seeds (excluding activities related to experiences provided within the venue)
- Sitting down or occupying space in a manner that obstructs other visitors' movement or viewing, or interferes with the organizer's operations.
- Setting up and using tents and similar items.
- In addition to the provisions set forth above, any attire that is contrary to public order and morals within the venue, or any conduct that disturbs the peace within the venue.

## 5. AND EXIT MEASURES EXIT MEASURES

In order to maintain public order and safety at the Expo Site, the Organiser may deny entry or implement measures to have persons who bring prohibited items or engage in prohibited acts exit the Expo Site.

Please note that if you are found to be in possession of prohibited items upon entry, the organizer will direct you to a storage facility, such as a coin-operated locker.

- Any person who do not comply with the Organiser's instructions under these Terms and Conditions (including rules regarding prohibited items and prohibited conduct)
- Any person deemed to pose a risk to public order and safety at the expo venue due to intoxication, aggressive or violent behavior, or abusive language.
- Any person who cause trouble with others or make those around them feel uncomfortable.
- A person who attempts to enter the Expo with a fake admission ticket
- A person who attempts to enter the Expo with an invalid ticket.
- Other persons deemed by the Organiser to be undesirable in the operation of the Expo Site from the viewpoint of ensuring safety, maintaining order, preventing terrorism, etc.in the Expo Site.
